PRAISE God for how amazing He is. - Thumb

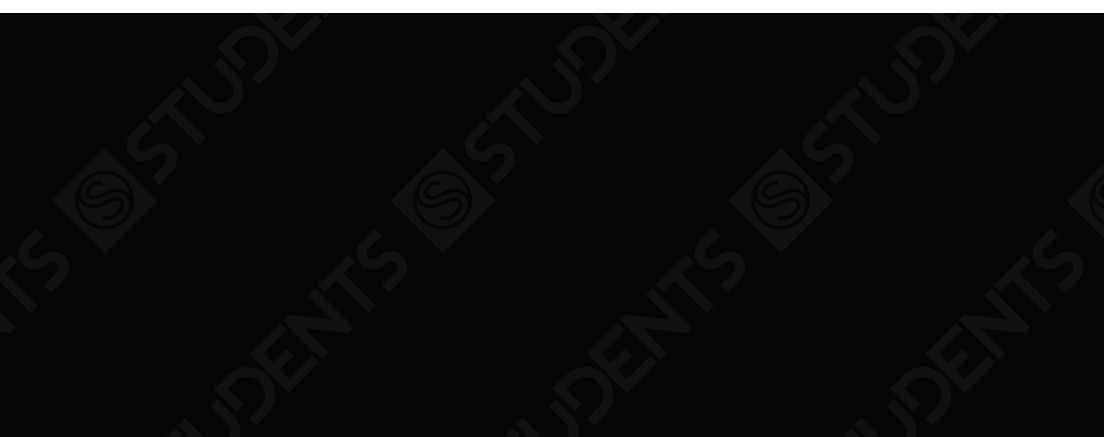
THANK God for all the ways He has blessed you. - Index finger
