

Creek Kids Day Camp

Camp 2025 FAQs

WHEN AND WHERE IS CAMP TAKING PLACE?

Creek Kids Day Camp is located at Stevens Creek Church - Augusta Campus (600 Stevens Creek Road, Augusta, GA) from June 9th-June 12th (9am to 3pm).

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost of camp is \$179 per camper. Except during Kickoff week (March 2nd-March 9th, 2025), the cost is \$149. That includes a t-shirt, snacks, and water day.

HOW DO I SECURE MY CAMPER'S SPOT?

March 2nd-March 9th: To secure your camper's spot at our Kickoff week price you must pay for your **camper in full**. If you are registering more than one camper you will receive a multi-sibling discount and you have the option to pay for the sibling(s) in full or pay a minimum \$25 deposit.

March 10th-June 1st: To secure your camper's spot you must pay a non-refundable deposit of \$25 (which is applied to the total cost).

We offer a \$20 discount per sibling after you pay for your first camper in full.

Any request for a full refund (minus the \$25 non-refundable deposit on all registrations) is due by April 20, 2025.

Payment in full is due by May 1, 2025.

CAN YOU ACCOMMODATE KIDS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS?

All children with special needs will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Please contact the church office to speak with our Creek Kids department.

WHO WILL BE WORKING WITH MY CHILD?

Each group will have four or more Creek Kids volunteers. All of our volunteers are screened and must pass a background check.

WHAT SHOULD I PLAN FOR MY CHILD TO WEAR?

Plan for summer in Georgia! But remember, this is a church camp. Shorts must be at least fingertip length and tube tops, cutoffs, crop tops and spaghetti straps will not be allowed. For any water events, girls should bring a one piece, full-coverage swimsuit, and boys must wear a t-shirt as well as modest swim trunks.

WHAT SHOULD I PLAN FOR MY CHILD TO BRING?

All campers must bring a packed lunch (we do not provide lunch). We encourage campers to bring as little as possible! We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

WHAT ABOUT MEDICATIONS?

We will collect all prescription medications at our Nurser's Station during check-in and they will be administered by our on-site camp nurse.

ARE YOU ABLE TO ACCOMMODATE FOOD ALLERGIES?

We are most likely able to help meet dietary requirements. Simply let us know in advance when you register your child for camp. Please be aware that we are not a peanut/nut free facility

HOW DO I GET IN TOUCH WITH MY CHILD?

Emergency numbers and much more information will be sent home with parents after registration and at check-in.
